Teaming Up to Kick - Out Domestic Abuse

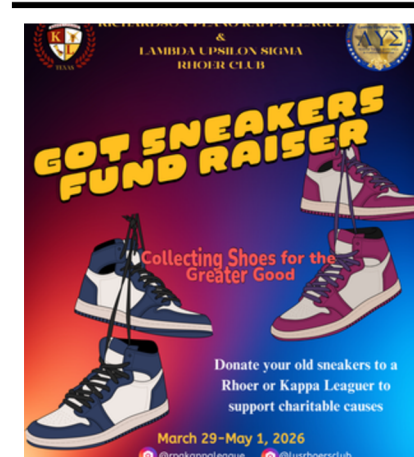


The Richardson-Plano Kappa Leaguers joined forces with the Rhoer Club of the Lambda Upsilon Sigma Chapter of Sigma Gamma Rho Sorority, Incorporated, in a community-driven effort to raise awareness and support for victims of domestic abuse.

The organizations hosted a unique sneaker fundraiser, collecting gently used athletic shoes that were refurbished and given new life through a sneaker revitalization program. Funds generated from the initiative were donated to the Genesis Women's Shelter & Support, a Dallas-based organization dedicated to providing safety, shelter, and resources to women and children affected by domestic violence.

Through this collaborative service project, the Richardson-Plano Kappa Leaguers and the Rhoer Club demonstrated their commitment to community engagement and social responsibility while helping support families impacted by domestic abuse.

The fundraiser not only promoted environmental sustainability through shoe recycling but also provided meaningful financial assistance to an organization working to break the cycle of violence and empower survivors.



Getting the Word Out

The Rhoers and Kappa leaguers leveraged their networks and the reach of social media to get the word out to their friends, family and the public at large. Through creative videos and flyers, the need was set, and their goals were met.

Working Together

The two groups melded seamlessly to exchange ideas and develop a strategy to maximize the fundraiser. They worked through a democratic process to vote on which organization the funds would benefit. The groups engaged in a light form of competition to see which group could collect the most shoes and which Rhoer or Kappa Leaguer from their respective group would collect the most.



Seeing Results

Through the group's efforts, 212 pairs of shoes were collected, filling 20 donation bags. This represents a monumental effort for each group, working hard to benefit those in need. We appreciate the support of our communities, and are willing to join the effort to kick out domestic abuse.
